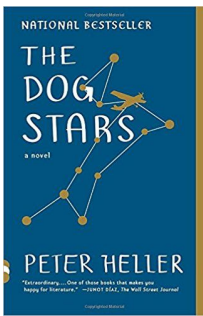

Thursday	noon - 4:00pm

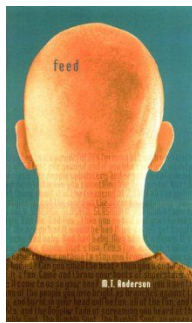

- All students taking honors English must **ALSO** read **one other book** from the choices below.



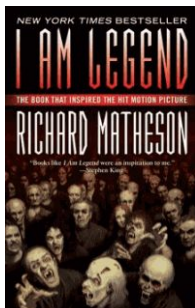
